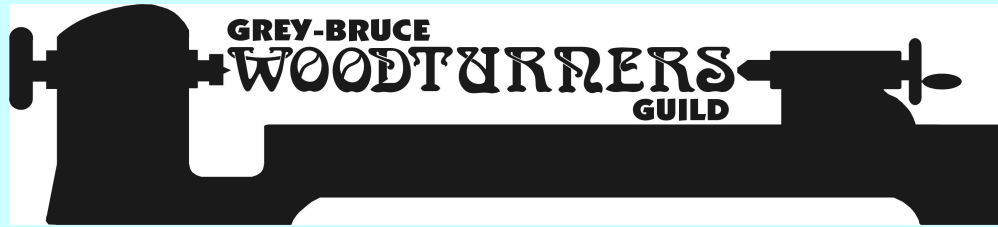

Jim O'Dell showing us his technique for turning a square box and square plate

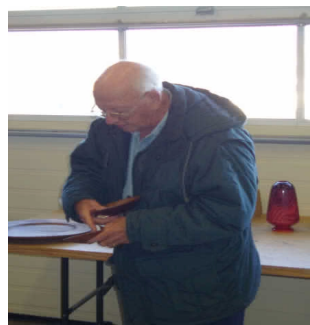
What a great turn out we had for this months meeting. With 27 members in attendance we are sure to see some square turnings during show and tell in the near future.
