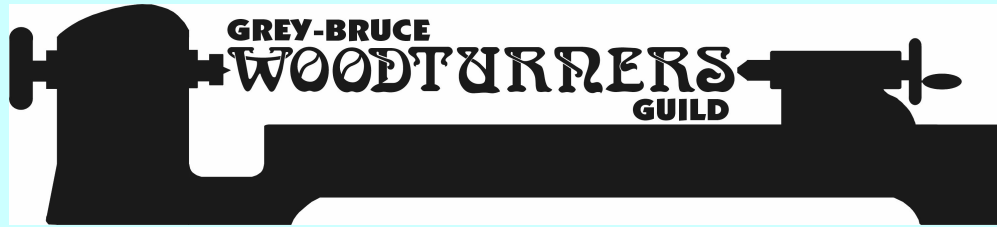

TOM HURST DEMONSTRATION OFF SET TURNING

We had a wonderful day June 16 when Tom came to our meeting to demonstrate “Offset Turning”.

Unfortunately we did not have the regular turnout, but those who came out thoroughly enjoyed the day.

First he showed us the technique for “Lattice Turning” and then demonstrated how to make a “Saueracker Shell“. Handouts were distributed to explain both of these techniques.

Tom had time to also demonstrate the offset turning of tool handles which are flat on two sides so they do not roll around when laying on your work bench.

After that he turned a base for wine glasses.
